What is a Working with Children Check (WWCC)?

A WWCC is a card issued by the Department of Justice that will enable you to meet a requirement of volunteering at Hawthorn Catholic Parish. There is no cost for a Volunteer WWCC application.



What if I already have a valid WWCC?

1. To link the WWC card to Hawthorn Catholic Parish:

Go online to www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au and on the Home page select **UPDATE MY DETAILS**. Alternatively, call **1300 652 879** to update your details over the phone.

How do I apply for a WWCC?

- 1. You will need:
- Access to internet
- 2 An email address
- 2 Address of every place you have lived in the last 5 years within Australia
- 2. Go online to www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au on the Home page select APPLY FOR A CHECK and then follow the prompts, ensuring that you link Hawthorn Catholic Parish as an organisation to your application.

3. Lodging your application

When you have completed the online application, you will receive an email confirmation with a barcode. Go to an Australia Post outlet to lodge your application.

You will need to show:

- 2 A printed application OR the barcode on your smartphone
- 2 100 points of ID (if you DID NOT verify your identity online)
- The outlet will take your photo for the card at no charge
- 4. No further action is required the Department of Justice will notify you and the Hawthorn Catholic Parish
